Mary Delphine (Broer) Carbaugh was born January 1, 1930 at Ohiowa, Nebraska and passed away Saturday, December 10, 2016 at Heritage Crossings in Geneva Nebraska at the age of 86. She was the youngest of three children born to John Henry Broer and his wife Joanna Marie (Leo) Broer.

Delphine was baptized March 20, 1934 and confirmed November 18, 1951, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning Nebraska.

She was a life member of the Durham Mammon Legion Auxiliary in Bruning and a member of the VFW Auxiliary 5328 of Hebron.
