



Anna Marie (Harre) Williamsen

Anna Marie (Harre) Williamsen was born on May 21, 1937, in Exeter, Nebraska, to Jerome Peter and Henrietta Josephine (Roeser) Harre. She passed away on September 5, 2025, at Windsong Memory Care in Petaluma, California, at the age of 88.

Anna Marie was one of seven children and grew up in the Exeter area. She attended St. Stephen's Grade School and graduated Valedictorian from Exeter High School with the Class of 1955. On August 13, 1955, she was united in marriage to Merrill Lee Williamsen in Exeter, Nebraska. Five children were born to this union. Merrill preceded her in death on November 1, 1989.

Annie and Merrill began their married life in Exeter before moving to San Rafael, California. They later returned to Fairmont, Nebraska, for two years before settling in San Anselmo, California. The family remained in California for the rest of their lives.

While living in California, Annie attended Marin Junior College, where she earned a degree in Bookkeeping. She worked as a Bookkeeper throughout her career until retiring in 2012, she later made her home in Rohnert Park, California. In 2020, Anna moved to Windsong Memory Care in Petaluma, California, where she resided until her passing.

Annie enjoyed baking cookies, country music, going to the movies, socializing with friends, and caring for her family. She led an active life and especially loved hiking the hills of Marin County and Point Reyes National Seashore.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Jerome and Henrietta Harre; her husband, Merrill Williamsen; her brothers, Robert Harre and Joseph Harre, and Joseph's wife, Diane; and her daughter, Lori Guliaeff.
