Barbara Lou (Dow) Frieden was born to Alvie and Mildred (Northrup) Dow on December 4, 1930 at Brady, Nebraska. She passed away on Wednesday, April 12, 2023 at York General Hearthstone in York, Nebraska at the age of 92 years, 4 months, and 8 days. She was the oldest of three children.

When Barbara was a small child, the family moved to Thayer County where she attended several country schools as well as the Belvidere schools. She was baptized at the Belvidere Christian Church.

Barbara married Clifford Pierce in 1947. They traveled throughout the Midwest

racing their thoroughbred horses. Barbara then continued with her love of animals by working at an animal clinic in Omaha.

On November 10, 1983 Barbara married Claton Frieden. They owned the Napa Auto Parts store in Wilber, Nebraska for a number of years and then in 1994 they moved to Shickley, Nebraska.

Barbara was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church, LWML, Ladies Aid and the Legion Auxiliary. Barbara loved to sew and was an accomplished quilter, taking her wares to many craft shows.

Due to poor health, Barbara and Claton moved to Mahoney House in York, Nebraska in 2013. Claton passed away on April 21, 2015.

Barbara was preceded in death by her husband; infant child; her parents; sister, JoAnn Jackson; brothers-in-law and sister-in-law, Ronald K. Widler, Gerald Crone, and Earl Dean & Velda Frieden.

She is survived by her sister, Marilyn Widler of Geneva; sisters-in-law Ila (Wayne) Nelson of Hastings, Sherrill Crone of Hastings and Opal (Lawrence) Griess of Sutton; numerous nieces and nephews, other relatives and friends.

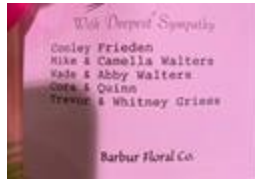
