Beau D. Cruse, age 37, of Lincoln, Nebraska., passed away on May 29, 2025, at his home in Lincoln. He was born to Marc and Lynne (Schuchart) Cruse on August 17, 1987, in Lincoln. Following college, Beau pursued a career in both the restaurant and golf industries. His true pride and joy, however, was his daughter, Alyka Gubbels, born April 6, 2009. Beau cherished every moment spent with Alyka and held their bond close to his heart.

Sports remained a lifelong passion. He avidly followed soccer, football, and golf, and even returned to the soccer field as a youth coach while living in Omaha. His favorite teams included the New Orleans Saints and Manchester United.
