



## Betty Ann Houck

July 23, 1945 - July 22, 2021

Betty Ann (Shipferling) (Kramer) Houck was born to Carl & Doris (Rhoads) Shipferling on July 23, 1945 at Lutheran Hospital in York, Nebraska, and passed away July 22, 2021 at CHI-St. Elizabeth Hospital in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 75 years, 11 months, 30 days. She was one of three children born in the family.

Betty was raised in York. She went to York Highschool where she first met Darwin before they went their separate ways. Betty married Robert Kramer on May 25, 1964. To this union five children were born: Steven, Johnnie, Laurie, Kathy & Kellie. Betty stayed home with the children until she returned to work at A&W Root Beer and then Kentucky Fried Chicken.
