Bonnie Belle Crooker was born to Claude Wallace Crooker and Alda Violet (Anderson) Crooker on February 24, 1924 in Koshopah, Nebraska. She passed away April 17, 2018 at Heritage Crossings Nursing Home in Geneva, Nebraska at the age of 84 years, 1 month, and 24 days. She was one of thirteen children in the family.

Bonnie received her 8th grade education before marrying Kenneth John Mizner of Ainsworth, Nebraska on March 30, 1950. Seven children were born to this union.
