Brenda graduated from Davenport High School in 1976. She attended Mary Lanning School of Nursing graduating in 1979. She went on to earn her Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Omaha in 1985. Brenda was active in the Girl Scouts, Pep Club and Methodist Youth Fellowship.

Brenda married Paul Mumm on November 19, 1977 at the Methodist Church in Davenport Nebraska. To this union Brian and Ivan were born. Family was very important to Brenda. This was evident by all of the family events Brenda and Paul hosted over the years.

Brenda was a very devoted nurse over the years by working various positions. She worked as a floor nurse, outpatient coordinator, home health and director of nursing at Fillmore County Hospital. She was also a Utilization Review nurse at York General Hospital and finished her career at Aseracare and Heritage Crossings in Geneva before her illness made it impossible to work.
