Carol Jane (Albro) Sieber was an only child born to Lewis B. Albro and Helen F. (Ward) Albro on August 14, 1947, at Omaha, Nebraska. She passed away June 13, 2013, at Bryan Memorial in Lincoln, Nebraska, at the age of 65 years, nine months and 29 days.

Carol grew up on the family farm north of Geneva and attended country school and later graduating from Geneva High School in the class of 1965. Carol was married to Richard L. Sieber of Ohiowa, Nebraska, on December 8, 1962, and to them three children were born.

Carol lived in and around Geneva until 1965 when Carol and her family moved to Lincoln. In 1969 they moved back to the family farm and lived there ever since.

While in Lincoln, Carol was employed by Tony and Luigi's, a fine Italian restaurant. After returning to the farm, Carol had several jobs. These included working at the local trailer house factory, bartending at Sportsmans, flagging for Biba Construction and her favorite, working as a cottage parent at the Geneva Youth Development Center. Carol also owned and operated Pinetree Antiques in Geneva for many years. It was her proudest accomplishment. The thrill of the hunt as well as preparation and selling of antiques was part of her and always will be.

Carol was a member of First Congregational United Church of Christ in Geneva for 55 years. She was a 38-year member of Order of Eastern Star Chapter 180 in Geneva including past Worthy Matron and past Grand

Representative to Scotland in Nebraska. Carol served as a Boy Scout mother and supporter and attended bible study with many friends.

Carol was preceded in death by her father Lewis B. Albro and mother Helen F. Ward of Geneva. She is survived by her husband Richard L. Sieber of Geneva and sons Lewis R. Sieber (and wife Karen) of Lincoln, Michael L. (and wife Natalie) of Ohio and Timothy A. (and wife Michelle) of Johnston, Iowa.

Carol is also survived by 13 grandchildren and 13.5 great-grandchildren.

Memorial service for Carol will be Friday, June 21, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Geneva, Nebraska. Private committal of ashes will be at a later date in the Geneva Public Cemetery.
