Dale William Schram was born to Donald Schram & Mildred Fanny Ellis on November 6th, 1938 in Allen, Nebraska, and passed away July 15th, 2019 at Bryan East hospital in Lincoln, NE at the age of 80 years, 8 months, and 9 days. He was one of 5 children.

Dale was married to Neva Lee Hulse on December 27th, 1956 and to them, 6 children were born. The couple adopted & fostered many additional children throughout their lives together.

Dale worked as a diesel mechanic much of his life, spending long days in the sun; so much so that many who knew him thought that his dark complexion was natural (they never saw him in shorts). When he wasn't working, Dale could be found working on one vehicle or another; sometimes repairing, sometimes restoring.

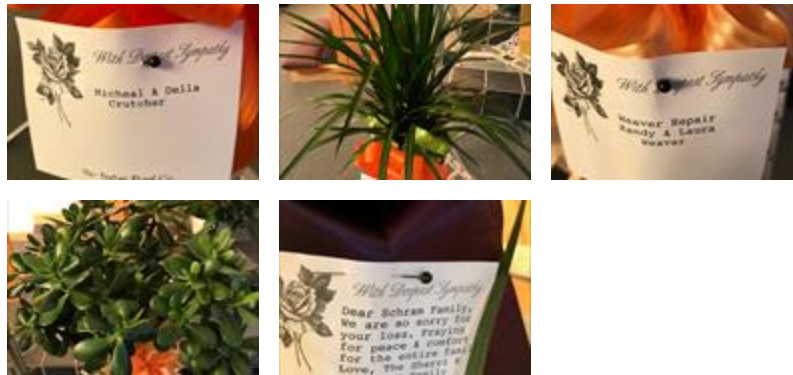
