Dana Corbin Lauber was born to Bradley A. Lauber and Patricia J. (Meehan) Lauber on June 2, 1988, in York, Nebraska. He passed away in Geneva, Nebraska on Saturday, September 24, 2022, at the age of 34 years, 3 months, and 22 days. He was the youngest of three children in his family. Dana grew up in Geneva, Nebraska. He graduated from Fillmore Central High School with the class of 2006. Dana was out for football and golf throughout his years in school. He also participated in the band and choir. Dana attended the University of Nebraska-Lincoln after graduating from high school. He was a student there for 5 years and a member of the Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity. Dana met his future wife, Whitney Bowman, at a young age. During their senior year, they began dating and continued as they both moved to Lincoln in August of 2006. After several years together, Dana married his high school sweetheart in his mother's backyard on May 31, 2014, surrounded by friends and family. They enjoyed their early days of marriage living in the country, but they eventually moved to Dana's childhood home where they built their life together, raising 4 beautiful children: Oliver (9), Lucy (6), George (4), and Vivian (6 Months).

Dana was loved by all who knew him. He was laid back and would always go with the flow. Dana was a box full of knowledge and he would spend many late nights around the table discussing anything including coins, farming, politics, and investments.

Dana had a passion for farming from birth as he grew up working on the family Seed Corn farm, and he moved back home to follow the family tradition. He and his two brothers worked side by side, even starting a business of their own. He enjoyed discussing all things related to farming and shared that joy with his children often. When Dana wasn't working on the farm, he was usually found out on the lake fishing or playing a round of golf. He was a fan of the band "Clutch" and even after frequent denials, he was a BIG fan of Elton John.

Dana loved his children and his wife dearly and enjoyed spending time with them. They spent many holidays driving around looking at Christmas lights, decking the house out in all the glitz and glitter, and even insisting on the tree being assembled before Thanksgiving. The Lauber family was also known for putting on the biggest display of fireworks Fillmore County has ever seen on the 4th of July. During his free time, Dana and Whitney enjoyed traveling to Texas and Colorado with their children for family vacations.
