



Daniel L. Waldron

June 29, 1933 - December 29, 2019

Dan L. Waldron was born to Frank and Helen (Binger) Waldron on June 29, 1933 at York, Nebraska, and passed away December 29, 2019, at Heritage Crossings in Geneva, Nebraska, at the age of 86 years, 6 months. He was one of 4 children in the family.

Dan graduated from York High School in 1950. He married Dolores Stengel of York, Nebraska, at the United Methodist Church in York on August 23, 1953, and to them 4 sons were born. They lived in Tucson and Geneva, owning the West Side Café and Pastime Bar. Also, Dan worked at Geneva Implement for 33 years, with most of those years as the Parts Manager. Dolores passed away on December 30, 1984. After retiring in 1988, Dan worked another 14 years for the Fillmore County Weeds Department during the summers.

On February 8, 1986, Dan married Melva (Bockus-Burger) Waldron at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Steinauer, Nebraska. Melva passed away on July 19, 2018.

Dan retired at age 65 and enjoyed spending over 15 winters in Tucson Arizona.

Throughout his adult life he was bound & determined to vacation in all 50 states! He took great pride in his home, yard, and car. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church for 33 years and also a member of Knights of Columbus for 20 years.
