Del's hobbies included Fantasy sports (at one time he had 60 teams), weekly coffee group, and liked to be helpful.

While living in Lincoln, he graduated from Southeast Community College with a degree in CDL Trucking. He drove Semi's for a short time and decided to stop after kidney stones interfered with his driving carrier and he missed being home.
