Dennis Lee Bumgarner was born to Homer & Gloria (Norder) Bumgarner on May 24, 1943 in Strang, Nebraska. He departed this life on August 27, 2021 due to complications from Parkinson's Diseases at Eastmont Towers in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 78 years, 3 months and 3 days.

Denny, as he was affectionately known, was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska. He attended Bruning Public School and graduated with the class of 1961. He then attended Lincoln School of Commerce. Denny joined the United States Army on October 7, 1964 and was honorably discharged on March 20, 1965.

Denny became a realtor in Lincoln and slowly bought and managed properties of his own. He also returned to Bruning for many years to help his parents with the farming operation.

Denny enjoyed hunting and fishing. He also loved "mother nature," respecting and admiring the land and all of the animals. He loved to dance, twirling his partner all around the floor! Denny had a big heart, and his humor and kindness to others was legendary. The people at Eastmont Towers were entertained by his jokes, pranks, smile and his thoughtfulness.
