



## Dolores M. Johnson

January 30, 1926 - February 9, 2019

A Funeral Service for Dolores was held on Friday, February 15, 2019, at 10:30 a.m., at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska with Pastor Stuart Sell presiding.

Dolores Marie Johnson was born January 30, 1926 in Bruning, NE to Henry and Ella (Wilhelms) Norder. She died February 9, 2019 at Heritage Crossings

in Geneva, NE of natural causes.

Dolores grew up on a farm north of Bruning which had been “Prairie Star” the original Bruning post office. “Lorsey” as many knew her preferred to be outdoors and later told stories about her life on the farm including playing in the cow tank with her siblings.

A lifetime member of Trinity Lutheran Church, she was baptized February 21, 1926 and confirmed March 17, 1940. She was active in Bible study, Women’s Circle, and serving in the church. She graduated from Bruning High School in 1943. Dolores and her sisters sang together from an early age, learning how to harmonize from their mother. Music was the center of many family events. She often spent time living with and helping Uncle Walter and Aunt Ollie Hofrichter on their farm south of Bruning, and later worked at their drug store.

On September 15, 1956, she was united in marriage to Gaylord Newell Johnson. Together they raised four children. Their Bruning home was an inviting place for countless family members and friends.

Dolores was a fun-loving and positive person. Her life was not always easy but she never complained. She greeted everyone with a smile and a warm and caring heart. Her quick wit was amusing and her giggles were contagious. She had a special twinkle in her eye for her grandchildren. She was a loving wife, mother and grandmother — teaching her family by example the importance of compassion, sharing, caring, and hard work. She lived a full and beautiful life.

She had many hobbies including sketching, painting, gardening & canning, sewing, crochet, fishing with Gaylord, shopping, baking and cooking, and doing crossword puzzles in ink. She spent many hours patiently teaching her children and grandchildren these interests.

Dolores was preceded in death by her husband of 60 years, Gaylord Johnson and her parents, Henry and Ella Norder. Also preceding her in death were sisters Gloria (Mrs. Homer Bumgarner), Gwendolyn (Mrs. Don Lawson), Shirley (Mrs. Don Braun); brother Larry Norder; and son-in-law Gary Dittmer.
