Donna Mae (Petersen) Jasinski, of Cordova, died suddenly, Monday, July 22, 2019 at the age of 81 years, 2 months, and 6 days. She was born May 16, 1938 to Ray M. and Phyllis M. (Kleinschrodt) Petersen in Exeter, Nebraska. She was one of 2 children born in the family.

Donna attended Exeter High School and graduated in 1955. After graduation, she worked in Lincoln in the Insurance & Banking industry. While in Lincoln, she met the love of her life Henry "Hank" Jasinski. They married on October 18, 1958 and to them 3 children were born; Tammy, Gary and Scott.

She and Hank moved back to Cordova and farmed before purchasing and running Hank and Donna's Tavern for 30 Years. Lifelong special friendships and special memories came from this adventure. Hank and Donna sold the bar in August of 2002.

Family was a treasure to Donna. Special times included following the Granddaughters in their athletic competitions. She also enjoyed communicating on Facebook, Taco Tuesdays, Red Hat Gatherings, camping and fishing trips and watching the Great Grandchildren grow.

She was an active member of the Zastrow Cemetery Board, Cordova Community Club and Trinity Lutheran Church in Cordova. Donna was very

proud of her Hometown Cordova, setting on the porch watching the neighborhood kids, grandkids, etc. ride their bikes, 4-wheelers, scooters and visiting with those passing by.

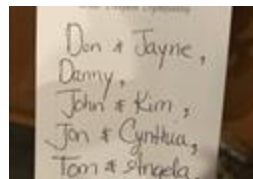
