



Douglas R. Fintel

May 13, 1953 - December 22, 2025

A Memorial Service for Doug will be held on Friday, December 26, 2025, at 2:00 p.m., at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska with Pastor Leah Krotz presiding.

No visitation will be held as it was Doug's wishes to be cremated.

Committal of Ashes will be held following the Memorial Service at the Trinity Lutheran Cemetery in Bruning, Nebraska.

Memorials are to be directed to the family to be designated at a later date.

Douglas (Doug) R. Fintel was born May 13, 1953 in Hebron, Nebraska, to Walter & Ida (Wertsbaugh) Fintel. He was baptized June 9, 1953, at Peace Lutheran Church in Deshler and confirmed in 1967 at Trinity Lutheran Church - Friedensau. Doug departed his earthly life at the age of 72 on December 22, 2025, Fillmore County Hospital in Geneva, Nebraska.

In April of 1954, Walter chose to have Doug live with his Aunt & Uncle, Matilda & Earl Werner of rural Carleton, calling them Mom & Dad. He gained older siblings Mary Ann & Eugene. Walter later remarried & Doug would get to spend a few weeks each summer with his Dad, step-mom Shirley & younger siblings Kirk, Linda & Mark, who resided in Lincoln.

Doug attended Kindergarten at Carleton Public School, Elementary at Friedensau Lutheran School, 7-8 grades at St Peters Lutheran School in Deshler & high school at Bruning Public School, graduating in 1971.

On June 2, 1973, at 20 years old, he married his high school sweetheart, Janice Edzards, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, and were blessed with children Amy Christine in August of 1978 & Aaron Todd in December of 1982.

Doug grew up on the Werner Dairy south of Carleton, which instilled the 'can't just sit idle' work ethic in him. He worked the dairy with his parents, brother & brother-in-law until Janice's dad retired from farming in the mid-1970's. In 1981, Doug, Janice & Amy moved out to the Edzards' family farm on Hwy 4. On June 12, 1984, a violent tornado completely

flattened the farm & destroyed all their farm machinery. They rebuilt in the same place and moved into the new home the week before Thanksgiving in 1984. Doug & Janice worked incredibly hard to rebuild the farming operation and Doug was still the 'combine captain' this past fall. Although he had passed the farming torch to Aaron and his oldest grandson, Hunter, he was still involved in the day to day as much as he could. You would always see Doug driving his white Chevy pickup on the same route twice a day checking on the fields and his friends. Several people said that you could set your watch by Doug's 'tootling' time – usually 10 am & 4:30 pm is when the trip would start.

Doug enjoyed league bowling for years at Blue Valley Bowl in Hebron. Many a crazy story was told about adventures to state bowling tournaments.

Later in life Doug found himself emersed in the game of golf. He was a member of the Hebron Country Club for many years and thoroughly enjoyed being a member of the men's golf leagues. There wasn't a tournament he wouldn't play in. His favorite golf partner was his son, Aaron, and they placed in several tournaments at Hebron, Friend & Geneva over the years. They were fortunate enough to be able to go play several different courses together as well, such as Tiburon in Omaha & Quarry Oaks by Ashland. Doug & Amy were also known to hit up the couples tournaments in the area when they could.

Doug was preceded in death by parents Walter & Shirley Fintel, Earl & Matilda Werner, in-laws Alton (Tony) Edzards & Ardean Edzards Cogger, brother Eugene Werner, brother-in-law Richard Edzards & nephew Bryan Heinrichs.

Doug is survived by his wife of 52 years Janice, daughter Amy & husband Aaron Peterson, son Aaron Fintel & wife Jodi, grandsons Hunter Fintel, Hudson Fintel, Asher Peterson & granddaughter Aeryn Peterson, all of Bruning; sister Mary Ann & husband Larry Heinrichs of Davenport; sister-in-law Elaine Werner of Carleton; brother Kirk & wife Margaret Fintel, sister Linda & husband William Masters, Jr., & brother Mark Fintel, all of Lincoln; brother-in-Law Larry & wife Betty Edzards of Bruning; sister-in-law Nancy Edzards of Omaha; as well as nieces, nephews, cousins & friends.
