Earl C. Bleach was born to James L. Bleach and Florence M. (Jeffres) Bleach on May 4, 1930, at Burwell, Nebraska and passed away on March 12, 2013, at the Wilber Care Center in Wilber, Nebraska at the age of 82 years.
