Elaine Rachel Lutz was born to Philip Henry Lutz, Jr. and Sophia Henrietta (Maler) Lutz on September 25, 1937 at the family farm near Fairmont, Nebraska. She passed away on October 21, 2024 at the Hearthstone in York, Nebraska at the age of 87 years and 26 days. She was the youngest of 7 children in the family.

Elaine grew up on the family farm. She was baptized and confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Cordova, and she remained a life-long member. She attended school in McCool Junction, and graduated with the class of 1955.

Elaine cared for parents in their later years. She also worked at the Fairview Manor in Fairmont, Nebraska. She later took employment as a bookkeeper for the Coop in McCool Junction, Nebraska, remaining there until her retirement.

Though she never had a family of her own, Elaine made an impact as a foster parent, fostering 4 girls for over 10 years. This was a very rewarding experience for Elaine.

Elaine enjoyed tending to her flowers and gardening. She transitioned to the Hearthstone in May of 2020 and remained there until her death.

Elaine was preceded in death by her parents, Philip & Sophia Lutz; siblings, Anna Lutz, Velma Selvig & husband Bob, Ruth Lutz, Vera Blum & husband Harold, Bernard Lutz & wife Velma, and Gerald Lutz.

She is survived by her sister-in-law, Dora Jane Lutz of Henderson, NE; and numerous nieces and nephews.

A Funeral Service for Elaine was held on Thursday, October 24, 2024 at 10:30 a.m. at St. John's Lutheran Church in Cordova, Nebraska. Blake Woodburn accompanied the congregation in the singing of "How Great Thou Art," "What A Friend We Have In Jesus," and "Amazing Grace."
