



## Elfrieda A. Jensen

January 16, 1921 - November 30, 2014

Elfrieda (Erks) Jensen was born Jan 16, 1921 on a farm near Gresham, Nebraska to Dietrich J. Erks and Minnie E. (Melford) Erks, and passed away on November 30, 2014 at the Exeter Care Center in Exeter, Nebraska at the age of 93 years, 10 months and 15 days.

Elfrieda was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church north of Utica, Nebraska and was also confirmed there in 1934. She attended High School in Utica, Nebraska and graduated in 1938. After graduation she went to beauty school and became a beautician. She owned & operated a beauty shop in Gresham from 1940 thru 1944.
