



## Erma Jean Lundberg

Erma Jean Lundberg was born to Lloyd Thomas Dunlap and Adelia Pearl Tibbetts on October 10, 1929 in Irving, Kansas and passed away at the age of 94 on July 15th, 2024 at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, Nebraska. She was one of two children in the family.

During high school at Cleburne, Kansas, Erma Jean was an outstanding basketball player and also participated in track and softball. After high school she worked in the office of the Clerk of District court and Treasure office in Westmoreland, Kansas. Due to the building of the Tuttle Creek Dam near Manhattan, Kansas, the family moved to the farm in Fairmont, Nebraska in 1960. Erma Jean raised her family and worked alongside Raymond on the farm. With her children grown, Erma Jean worked at Pieper Hardware and True Value in York, Nebraska.

Erma Jean was member of the Fairmont Community Church and UMW. She enjoyed Sunday services. Going out for lunch and card games with her friends after church service were events she looked forward to. Erma was a member of the Faithful Workers Extension Club. On the farm, Erma Jean enjoyed gardening, flowers and especially her pets. Attending the activities of her grandchildren were events she thoroughly enjoyed. She was a consistent

attendee at water exercises in York for many years. Raymond and Erma Jean took many trips to visit relatives and friends in Kansas as well as trips to Branson and Hawaii. Fall Saturdays were for watching Husker football and she was also an avid Husker volleyball fan and all Kansas State athletics. The most important part of her life were her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She cherished every family gathering.

Preceding her in death were husband, Raymond; parents, Lloyd and Adelia Dunlap; brother, Gerald Dunlap; and grandson, Joey Ray Lundberg.
