Esther Weisgerber Domeier was born to Henry John Mueller and Muriel Spragg Mueller on May 27, 1919 in Brown County, Nebraska, and passed away peacefully on the morning of September 28, 2015, at Heritage Crossings in Geneva, Nebraska, at the age of 96 years, 4 months and 1 day.

Esther married Alex Weisgerber on June 6, 1942 at Ft. Lewis, Washington. After Al returned from serving in WWII in Europe, they lived in Mitchell and Scottsbluff, raising their four daughters, and later enjoying their grandchildren and other family, until Al's passing in 1981. Esther taught Kindergarten and 1st grade for many years. After much hard work, she received her teaching diploma at the age of 51. She was married to Harlen Domeier of Geneva from 1984 until his passing in 2001.

Esther was preceded in death by her husband Alex Weisgerber, daughter Linda Burns, brothers Loren and Roger Mueller, and husband Harlen Domeier.
