Evelyn graduated from Geneva High School in 1943. She worked as a secretary at the Fairmont Air Base. After the war, she and a friend moved to Denver where her first date with Robert Dunwoody was at a dance at Elitch Gardens. They were married six weeks later on October 25, 1946. They had a

daughter and a son and when Robert graduated from Colorado School of Mines in 1949, they started moving. They moved 45 times living in Louisiana, Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, New Jersey, Illinois, Tripoli, Libya, Singapore, Taipei, Taiwan and finally back to Nebraska. They were married for 57 years.

Evelyn's hobbies and interests were family, cards, bowling, golf, beading, knitting, dominoes, dogs and watching sports.

Evelyn was preceded in death by her husband, Robert: parents, Tom and Anna Brower; brothers, Billy Brower and Barney Brower; sisters, Doris Rocolle, Frances Chapman and Carol Schafer.

She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Pamela and Merlin Green of Lincoln, NE; son and daughter-in-law, John and Alicia Dunwoody of Oxnard, CA and many cousins.
