



Florinda R.I. Trapp

April 29, 1921 - February 12, 2013

Florinda Rose Irene (Moell) Trapp was born to David Herman Moell and Minna Alvina (Voss) Moell on April 29, 1921, at Carleton, and passed away Feb. 12, 2013, at Fillmore County Hospital in Geneva, at the age of 91 years, nine months and 14 days. She was one of five children in the family. Florinda was confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church in Carleton. She graduated from Carleton High School in 1938. Florinda married Lester Edward Trapp of Shickley on June 16, 1940, at Zion Lutheran Church in Carleton. She and Lester lived on a farm just south of Shickley. To them eight children were born. She was a homemaker all of her life, and worked out of the home at the Youth Development Center as a cottage mother, and also at the Fillmore County Hospital. The family moved to Shickley in 1960. Lester passed away in 1988. Florinda moved to Geneva in 1989. She entered Heritage Crossings in 2008, where she resided until her death. Florinda was preceded in death by her parents; husband; infant son, Edward Lee; daughter, Ruth Elaine; sister, Ardell Kassebaum; brother, Dale David Moell; and son-in-law, Evan Czirr. Surviving to mourn her loss are her children and their families, daughter, Beverly J. Czirr, Superior; sons, Richard D.(Dick) and Carol, Courtland; Thomas L. (Tom) and Barb, Geneva; William D. A celebration of life was conducted from Grace Lutheran Church in Geneva at 10 a.m. on Friday, Feb. 15, with the Rev. Stephen Kruschel officiating. Special music, "In the Garden" and "Just A Closer Walk With Thee" was provided by the Grace Lutheran choral group. Congregational hymns included "What A Friend We Have In Jesus," and "Amazing Grace." Casket bearers were grandsons, Honorary Casket bearers were all of her granddaughters and great-grandchildren.
