



Helen "Lucy" Lucile Voigt

March 12, 1922 - July 27, 2013

Memorial services for Lucy were held on Sunday, August 4, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. at the Davenport United Methodist Church. A private family inurnment was held at the Davenport Cemetery.

Helen Lucile (Lucy) Voigt was born on March 12, 1922, in Deadwood, SD, and died on July 27, 2013, in Hebron, NE. Her parents, Ernest and Helen Leverton, moved to Lincoln, NE, in 1925 with their three children (Ruth, Richard, and Helen Lucile). Lucy attended Lincoln Public Schools and graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1943. That same year she married her college sweetheart, Gerald (Bud) Wheeler Voigt.

Bud and Lucy made their home in Davenport, NE, and farmed with Bud's parents, Walter and Carrie Voigt. Lucy was a homemaker, a mother to their four daughters, and an active member of the community. She moved to Courtyard Terrace Assisted Living in Hebron, NE, after Bud's death in 2008.
