Jim was born on December 22, 1947, to Alfred and Ruth (Garwood) Quick in Geneva, Nebraska. He was the youngest of six children in the family. He was raised on the family farm east of Fairmont and attended school at Fairmont

Public School, graduating with the class of 1967.

During the summer of 1966, Jim started working for Nick's Farm Store in Geneva, where he remained employed until 1978. He always spoke fondly of his time working for Nick's. After leaving Nick's in 1978, he began driving semi-trucks with his brother, Richard, until June of 1983, when he went to work for the City of Geneva. During his time with the city, he worked as part of the street maintenance crew, then moved to Parks and Recreation, and finally, to maintenance of the city cemetery. He continued to care for the cemetery through the summer of 2025. Jim was also a fireman with the Geneva Volunteer Fire Department for 25 years.

Jim met his wife, Patricia, at a dance in Fairmont in the summer of 1982. They married on April 16, 1983. In Jim's own words, he and Pat liked travelling by car, tour bus, and occasionally by airplane. Whether it was family vacations, family reunions, visiting friends and family, going to Bailey and Wyatt's school and sporting events, going to church, sightseeing, or just going out to eat, they were always ready! During their marriage, they saw most of the United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, Canada, and took a cruise of the Caribbean Islands. Jim and Pat both agreed that their favorite trip was their 21-day trip to Alaska. They named their beloved dog, Kona, after returning from their Hawaiian Islands vacation.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Pat, in February of 2022, brothers, John and wife Doris, Bob and wife Dorothy, and Richard; sisters, Donna Rathje and husband Harry, Deloris Veskrna and husband Donald.

Those he leaves to mourn are son, Justin Sole, and friend Kenneth Knappert, sister-in-law, Mary Quick, many nieces, nephews, and cousins, and the Spencer Hafer family.
