



James S. "Jim" Sliva

March 22, 1942 - December 28, 2022

James S. "Jim" Sliva was the firstborn to Dennis and Josephine (Starzec) Sliva on March 22, 1942 in Columbus, Nebraska and passed away on December 28, 2022 at the Filmore County Hospital in Geneva, NE at the age of 80 years , 9 months, and 6 days.

He attended grade school at St. Michael's Catholic School in Tarnov, Nebraska and went to Humphrey High School in Humphrey, Nebraska graduating in 1960. He served in the US Army from July 8, 1960 to June 26, 1962 in Germany with the 2nd Infantry Division and 10th Artillery.

On May 14, 1966, he married Patricia (Pat) Furby and they had 5 children. He worked and was the General Manager at the Tarnov Grain Elevator which later became Farmers Cooperative Grain. In 1983 he was promoted to Grain Merchandiser/Broker and was transferred to the office and terminals in Osceola, Nebraska and Silver Creek, Nebraska. In 1986, Jim and Pat moved to the Shickley area where he also managed and brokered for elevators in Ong, Nebraska and Sedan, Nebraska. He retired when he was 62, affording him the opportunity to buy and travel to a home in Alamo, Texas for the winter seasons.

Jim was a devoted family man. He had a generous list of friends and his brothers and sister, along with their spouses, sat at the top of it. He was a sports enthusiast. He never missed the functions, events, and games of his kids and grandkids. He loved golf and played often. In fact, even last month he played a round. His golf buddies nicknamed him "The One-armed Bandit" (due to a hand amputation from a work injury in 1967) and shook their heads when he would outdrive or beat them. He was a huge NASCAR fan, boasting that he attended 30 races. He was fond of all college and professional athletics (both men's and women's) and playing poker, but he especially loved the Kansas City Royals and followed them faithfully. He was an active and faithful member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, American Legion Club, Ong Lion's Club, Retired Managers Association of Nebraska and Alcoholics Anonymous.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents, Dennis and Josie Sliva; brothers Bill Sliva and

Tom Sliva; infant sister, Mary; wife Pat; daughter Shana Sharon; infant granddaughter, Kamryn Kleinschmidt; and Son-in-law, Scott Miner.

Stanley Johnson was the organist and Becky Elznic was the Cantor and the hymns were "Amazing Grace," "Prayer Of St. Francis," "One Bread, One Body," "Song Of Farewell," and "Lead Me Lord."

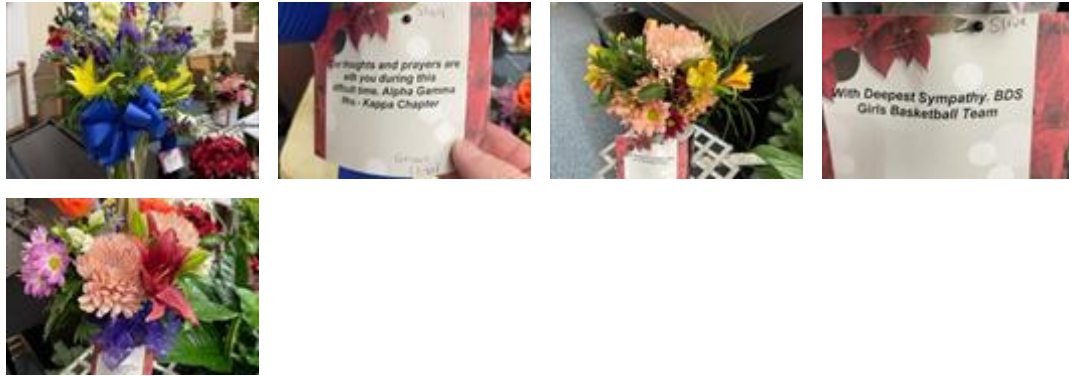

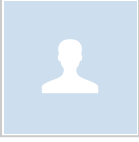
