James "Jimmy" Russell was born June 13, 1961 in Geneva, Nebraska to parents James G. & Beatrice Snodgrass and passed away on Monday, September 6, 2021 in Geneva, Nebraska at the age of 60 years.

He attended school in Fairmont. After graduating high school, he worked for several farmers before moving to Hastings, NE to work for Linweld. Several years later he transferred to Saint Joseph, MO still working for Linweld.

Jimmy was a very talented welder, and taught welding at the Community college in Saint Joseph for a short time. After leaving Saint Joseph, he bought an acreage in Fairmont, where in his free time he enjoyed working in his shop and helping Howard Lefler with planting and harvest.

Throughout his life, Jimmy was a jokester, and though he had no children of his own, he loved playing with his nieces, nephews, and other kids at family gatherings. He loved spending time with them as much as he loved mowing the acreage near Fairmont and going for drives in the country.

Jimmy was preceded in death by his grandparents, Russel & Edna Snodgrass and Uncle John (Jack) Snodgrass.

He is survived by his parents, sisters Julie (Dean) Dosch, Jodi (Brian) Hartman, long-time love Adrienne Heater, and many nieces and nephews.
