A survivor of childhood cancer, Jennifer understood courage from a young age. The experience shaped how she lived, never letting fear stand in the way of trying something new or stepping into the unknown.

Jennifer had a lifelong love of crafting and creativity, a talent she shared with her mother. She was especially drawn to art forms that required patience and precision, spending hours folding origami into delicate ornaments, creating nail art with sparkling jewels and vibrant colors, or crocheting skeins of yarn into beautiful scarves and blankets. Her biggest joy, however, wasn't in the making of these items, but in giving her handmade creations to those she loved.

Another passion of Jennifer's was technology and gaming. As a young adult, she bonded with her father over building custom computer systems at a time when the technology was

still emerging. That interest grew into a love for online gaming, where she formed lasting friendships with people from around the world.

Above all, Jennifer cherished friendship. She had a rare gift for connecting with people of all ages and backgrounds. Her genuine interest in others and willingness to engage with what mattered to them made it easy for her to form meaningful friendships wherever she went. Jennifer was never happier than when she was with her family and friends.

Jennifer is survived by her mother, Julia Martin, and a large extended family of aunts, uncles, and cousins.

She was preceded in death by her father, Leslie Martin; her grandparents Richard and Roberta Martin; and her grandparents John and Elsie Block.

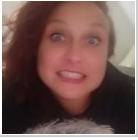
