The two spent many weekends square dancing, going to bowling tournaments, baseball games and traveling with family on vacation. They raised two daughters, Jamie and Marci.

Joan was a member of the Grace Lutheran Church in Geneva. She was active with the Ladies Aid group and the church choir. After retiring she enjoyed spending time at the Geneva Senior Center. She helped with many activities and for a while wrote stories for the Senior Newsletter. She also looked forward to her weekly coffee get-togethers with her neighborhood friends.

Joan loved being a wife, mom, grandma and great grandma. She was so happy whenever she got to spend time with her loved ones. She enjoyed going on family vacations, attending events for her daughters, baking cookies during the holidays, ceramics, playing family games, and always watched the
