He married Charlene L. Werner on June 1, 1946.

John started his working career at the Wilkins Steel Building Company and then became a Postal Carrier for the United States Post Office, delivering mail in Geneva, Nebraska and later in Lincoln, Nebraska until 1984 when he retired.

John was a lifetime member of the Geneva VFW – Samuel J. Marsh Post 7102 in Geneva, Nebraska and a lifetime member of the DAV, Chapter Seven and Legion Post 3 in Lincoln, Nebraska.

He was preceded in death by his parents; Henry and Cora (Oliver) Brower; his two infant sons; one sister and brother-in-law, Florence and Harold McCashland.

John is survived by his wife, Charlene, of Geneva, Nebraska; sons, James (Barbara) Brower of York, Nebraska; John (Kathleen) Brower of Geneva, Nebraska; daughters, Sharon (Jerry) Hockemeier of Eagle, Nebraska and Susan (Bill) Bettger of Geneva, Nebraska.

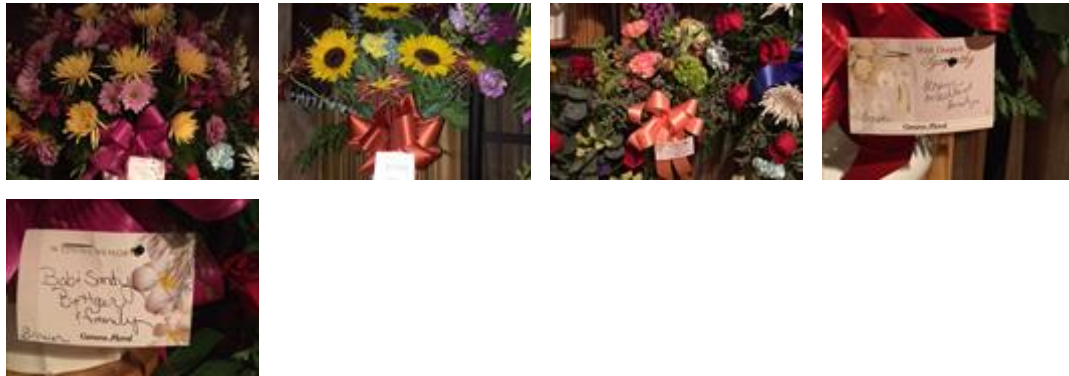
