Joshua Michael Towey was born to Patrick Thomas Towey & Anna Jean Swerczek on October 4, 1978 in Fullerton, Nebraska. He passed away on November 10, 2023 at Nebraska Medicine at Bellevue in Bellevue, Nebraska at the age of 45 years, 1 month, and 6 days.

Josh was baptized at St. Anthony Catholic Church in Cedar Rapids, Nebraska on October 8, 1978. He graduated from Albion Public School in 1996. After high school, Josh attended Wayne State College and obtained his bachelor's degree, graduating in 2000. He later attended the University of Nebraska and obtained a master's degree.

Josh had many talents and interests. Of those, he enjoyed music, hunting, travelling and baseball. He also had a way of connecting with youth in his position at the Boy & Girls Club of the Midlands. He spent 21 years with the organization and was well respected in his role. He demonstrated extreme dedication to his job wearing many hats including Sports, Fitness & Recreation Director, Program Director, Carter Lake Club Director, Director of Camp Nakomis, Boy & Girls Club of the Midlands Senior Grants Director, and most recently Director of Operations. As stated by Richard Webb, president of BGCM, Josh never shied away from hard work or a difficult task; he rather accepted those difficult tasks as a challenge for him to overcome. This pretty much defined who Josh was and how he went through life. His dedication to his career led to multiple awards including BGCM William R. Hinkley Distinguished Service Award, BGCA Merit Honor Award for Club Program Excellence, BGCA National Service to Youth Award. Josh's legacy and impact will be remembered for years to come, and he will be dearly missed by all that had the opportunity to know him.
