She was preceded in death by her husband Bob Murrell, father Myrl Ernst, mother Maebelle Ernst, brother Arly Ernst, her grandparents George and Elizabeth Decker who raised her, her daughter Patsy Jo Ahrens, grandson Zack Murrell and her husband's parents John and Julia Murrell who meant so much to her.
