Julie was a lifelong resident of Fairmont and graduated from Fairmont High School in 1978. She worked as a secretary for Frank Heinisch Law Office, Fillmore County Sheriff's Department, and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Police Department.

Julie was a loving, caring wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, daughter, sister, and friend whose heart was always focused on others. She was a natural caretaker; there was never a problem she couldn't fix or a person she wouldn't help. What brought Julie the greatest joy in life was taking care of those she loved.

While still underage, Julie once sat outside a bar waiting for him to come out, just so she could have a chance to talk to him. Their love story would last a lifetime. Julie and Dean were married on July 18, 1981, in Fairmont, Nebraska, at the Fairmont Community Church, and together they shared countless memories, laughter, and adventures. Although she loved traveling, Julie's heart always belonged to Hawaii.

She was an exceptional mother who worked tirelessly for her family. At times, she held down as many as three jobs while Dean worked on the road for BNSF. She truly loved her work in law enforcement and took great pride in serving others throughout her career.

In April of 1982, Julie and Dean welcomed their first child, Amanda, followed by Ashley and Jacoby. Julie loved her children deeply and was already ready and willing to help them, no matter the problem. During the early years of raising her children, Julie found joy in the simple things: gardening, hanging clothes on the clothesline each summer instead of using the dryer, and creating a warm and loving home.

She also treasured her friendship with her dear friend, Colleen. The two were inseparable, getting into playful mischief together in their old pickup truck,
