Funeral Services for Junior were held Saturday, August 10, 2013 at the Zion Lutheran Church rural Tobias, Nebraska.

Burial was in the Tobias Cemetery and memorials are directed to the family for later designation.

Junior Emil Bartels was born to Emil August Bartels and Hannah (Schafer) Bartels on April 1, 1926, at Tobias, Nebraska, and passed away on August 7, 2013 at Bryan East Hospital in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 87 years, 4 months, and 6 days. He was one of 3 children in the family.

He is survived by his wife Dorthy of Tobias; his sons Bob (Judy) Bartels of Tobias, Joe (Christine) Bartels of Seward, Dave (Lauren) Bartels of Omaha, Scott (Janette) Bartels of Western; daughter Pat (Dennis) DeWald of Omaha; brother Eugene (Beverly) Bartels of Tobias; sister Priscilla (Ben) Scholl of Tomball, Texas; 14 grandchildren and 20 great grandchildren.
