Keith Louis Kaderabek was born on November 30, 1965, in Lincoln, Nebraska. He passed away at Bryan West Medical Center on March 25, 2025 in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 59 years, 3 months and 25 days.

Keith was adopted by Joseph & Shirley (Turek) Kaderabek at a young age. He grew up on the farm outside of Ohiowa, Nebraska. He attended Ohiowa Public School until his Junior year. He then transferred to Milligan Public School and graduated with the class of 1984. After high school, he attended diesel technician school in Laramie, Wyoming, obtaining his Associate Degree in diesel mechanics.

On June 10, 1988, Keith was married to Angie Schoenholz. With this marriage, he adopted a daughter, Heather, and two additional daughters, Hailey and Harlee, were born to this union.

Keith enjoyed demolition derby's, Harley Davidson motorcycles, Czech music and especially cooking. He perfected cooking prime rib, and he specially prepared them for many people. Throughout the years, he also provided his cooking expertise to many dining establishments, helping in the kitchen at Kenny's Bar & Grill, Road Runner Bar & Grill, Brown's Lounge, Daddio's, and the Corner Tavern. In addition to cooking, Keith worked road construction for Webb Contracting, worked at Petersen Manufacturing, and most recently was employed at Bruning Grain & Feed.

Keith was preceded in death by father, Joe Kaderabek; and father-in-law & mother-in-law Rodney & Wanda Schoenholz.

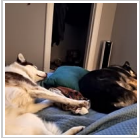

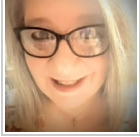
