He loved visiting with the children on his bus, as well as the boys he coached on his baseball team for many years. He truly cherished all of these memories and loved keeping in touch with all of his bus kids as they grew up and had children of their own.

Everyone always knew Larry was close by when they could smell the Captain Black cherry aroma of his pipe. Larry was such an avid Husker fan. He enjoyed going to Husker basketball and baseball games up until he couldn't anymore, but mom made sure to keep track of whenever the Huskers played on TV so that dad was sure to watch it. whenever he could. He definitely had the gift to gab and is catching up with everyone in heaven now.

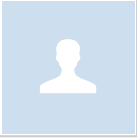
