Lawrence Lee Nutz Sr. was born on February 25, 1935 in Lincoln, Nebraska to Walter and Bertha (Sedam) Nutz. He passed away Sunday, December 25, 2022, at Filmore County Hospital in Geneva, Nebraska at the age of 87 years and 10 months.
