



LeRoy C. Hulse

November 13, 1936 - September 2, 2021

LeRoy Clarence Hulse was born to Clarence & Alberta (Lentfer) Hulse on November 13, 1936 at Bruning, Nebraska. He passed away at his home on Thursday, September 2, 2021 in Bruning, Nebraska at the age of 84 years, 9 months, and 20 days. LeRoy was the oldest of 4 children.

LeRoy was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska. He graduated from Bruning High School with the class of 1955. After graduation, LeRoy joined the United States Marine Corp in 1958 and served until he was honorably discharged in 1961.

On December 19, 1959, LeRoy married Bonnie Jean Dittmer in Bruning, Nebraska. From this union 3 children were born. They lived in San Diego, California until LeRoy was discharged from Marines. They then moved back to Bruning, Nebraska. LeRoy operated the West Side Café in Geneva, running the business for several years before selling out. The family then moved to Ohio, Nebraska for a year while LeRoy managed the grain elevator. From Ohio, the family moved to Iowa and LeRoy managed several different elevators for several years. LeRoy and Bonnie were able to buy a farm south of Glenwood, Iowa, and LeRoy farmed several years before selling the farm and retiring. After retirement, LeRoy and Bonnie moved back to Bruning where they made their home, also maintaining a home in Arizona during the winter months.

LeRoy enjoyed travelling and golf was his favorite pastime. He also enjoyed playing Texas Holdem', fishing, camping, watching his grandkids play sports, and just family time in general.

LeRoy was preceded in death by his wife, Bonnie and parents, Clarence & Alberta.

He is survived by his daughter, Kim (Neil) Houser of Malvern, Iowa; sons, Kelly (Michelle) Hulse of Sahuarita, Arizona and Kent (Barbara) Hulse of Olathe, Kansas; grandchildren, Ivan Houser, Marcus Houser, Jason Houser, Brandi Mott, Shaya Roesler, Eric Hulse and Andrea Hulse; great grandchildren, Breelynn Houser, Grayson Houser, Sadie Houser, Brayden Houser, Tyler Houser, Cameron Houser, and Skyllar Bolte; brothers, Larry (Sharon) Hulse of Bruning, Nebraska, James Hulse of Springfield, Ohio; sister, Marge (Robert) Bright of Rogers, Arkansas; and several nieces and nephews.

A Funeral Service for LeRoy was held on Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska. Pastor Stuart Sell officiated the Service. The recorded selections "Jealous Of The Angels" and "Amazing Grace" were played during the Service.

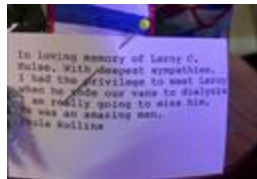
