



## Lewis F. "Bud" Garland

December 22, 1923 - May 28, 2012

Lewis Frederick Garland was born to Lewis H. Garland and Fern F. (Eppler) Garland on December 22, 1923, at Ohiowa, Nebraska and passed away May 28, 2012, at the Genoa Long Term Care in Genoa, Nebraska at the age of 88 years. He was one of 3 children in the family.

Lewis or as he was more commonly known, "Bud" lived in the Ohiowa area all of his life. He graduated from the Ohiowa High School in 1942 with honors.
