Poke Hollow Road behind Tater Ridge Road in West Union, Ohio.

Lois was raised in Greene County, Ohio on a dairy farm and was very active in 4H showing cattle in the county fair. She grew up in a musically talented family where they would enjoy getting together for a “jam session” or two-way into adulthood. Lois graduated from Cederville High School and went to business school in Ohio but then changed interests to become a telephone operator for Ma Belle. She joined the service and did boot camp at Fort Bennington, Georgia. She attended finance school in Indianapolis and was transferred to Fort Sill, Oklahoma. This is where she met Norris Bernasek and married in 1958. They moved to Nebraska to the farm. To this union four children were born. Following their divorce, Lois remained in Geneva.

Lois had a variety of skill sets and held several positions from owning a taxi cab business to being a seamstress, a paralegal, and at least 30 years in corrections for the State of Nebraska. She was most recently a dispatcher for the Fillmore County Sheriff’s Office until she retired last year. Lois had several hobbies including waterskiing, riding motorcycles, camping, knitting, and woodworking. However, her favorite things in life pertained to her family. She enjoyed all family activities including attending events for the kids, baking at holidays, family road trips, dancing, and vacations.

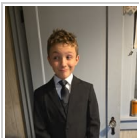
