May 15, 1944 - January 29, 2025

Lowell Melvin Anderson was born to Laurel 'Melvin' & DeVee Vivian (Weiss) Anderson on May 15, 1944 in Geneva, Nebraska and passed away on January 29, 2025 at The Hearthstone in York, Nebraska at the age of 80 years, 8 months, and 14 days.

Lowell grew up on the family farm. He was involved in 4-H and working with livestock and agriculture remained a very important part of his entire life. He excelled in education and fit well in the academic world.

Lowell attended Geneva Public School and graduated with the class of 1962. He continued his education with a bachelor's degree in Animal Science from University of Nebraska in Lincoln. He then enrolled at South Dakota State University obtaining his Master's Degree in Animal Science and his Ph.D., thus the title 'Dr. Lowell.' A true reflection of Lowell was his thesis title; "Temperature Computer Measurements, Productions and Carcass Traits of Individually Fed Weight Constant Beef Steers." He was always into detail and could remember everything.

Lowell was active in livestock judging and was on the UNL Livestock Judging Team. During one summer, he worked as an extension aid and coached a successful Fillmore County Judging team which received national honors.

His work career spanned a variety of jobs, opportunities and challenges, but all were pursued in earnest and with his best efforts. Livestock was always his first interest and what he was best at.

Lowell was a lifelong member of the United Methodist Church in Geneva. He served in various capacities at the church. He was a faithful “cameraman” videotaping the service and distributing copies to the community.

Lowell was always interested in his nephews’ and niece’s activities and then later in their children’s activities. He was continuously on the lookout for bargains, sometimes resulting in “unique” gifts for them for Christmas and their birthdays.

Lowell also enjoyed collecting farm toys of all sizes. Buying, selling, trading... but mostly buying.

He recovered remarkably from a stroke in 2017 after much physical rehabilitation. He lost much of the use of his right hand and had problems with his left leg, but it didn’t stop him from taking advantage of every opportunity for activities at York General Hearthstone. The Hearthstone gave him great care and he enjoyed being there and the staff enjoyed him.

Lowell was a happy-go-lucky guy and always had a smile on his face. He also loved to share a story with friends anytime he had the opportunity. He will be missed.

Lowell was preceded in death by his parents, Melvin & DeVee Anderson; brother & sister-in-law, Rodger & Roine Anderson; and nephews, Rodney Anderson & Ronald Anderson.

He is survived by his brothers, Bernard & Carol Anderson of York, Nebraska and Gary & Pat Anderson of Kearney, Nebraska; nephews, Darrell & Paula Anderson of Geneva, Nebraska, Doug & Tonya Anderson of Kearney,

Nebraska, Dennis & Elizabeth Anderson of Dallas, Texas, Larry Anderson of Phoenix, Arizona, Matt & Bev Anderson of Kearney, Nebraska, and niece, Andrea & James Sulhoff of Castle Rock, Colorado; and many great nieces and nephews.
