



## Marcy Jo (Jacobsen) Murphy

August 7, 1969 - August 7, 2024

Marcy Jo Murphy was born to Glenn T. Jacobsen & Patricia A. (Werner) Jacobsen on August 7, 1969 at Geneva, Nebraska. She died on August 7, 2024 at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, Nebraska at the age of 55 years. She was one of 4 children born in the family.

Marcy grew up in Fairmont, Nebraska and graduated from Fairmont High School with the class of 1987. She was married to Daniel Murphy on January 7, 1990 in Aurora, Nebraska. They made their home in Grant, Nebraska. Daniel and Marcy were involved in an automobile accident near Fairmont, Nebraska on June 22, 1990 that claimed Daniel's life. Marcy suffered a traumatic brain injury as a result of the accident, and she resided at Fairview Manor for 30+years. Marcy had many great caregivers at Fairview Manor, and the family was most appreciative of the care they provided her. Her mother was the most dedicated caregiver, visiting Marcy every day and never giving up on her daughter. Even though confined to the Fairview Manor, Marcy appreciated the visitors that came to see and interact with her.

Marcy was preceded in death by her father, Glenn Jacobsen; stepfather, Jerry Nutz; husband, Dan Murphy; and grandparents, Clyde & Marguerite Jacobsen and Lois Gravett.

She is survived by her mother, Pat Nutz of Fairmont, Nebraska; sisters, Deb & Steve Yates of Geneva, Nebraska, Jody & Troy Hemberger and Angela & Kyle McCown all of Lincoln, Nebraska; nieces & nephews Cale Yates, Shawn Yates, Taylor Hemberger and fiancé, Alex Wismer, Kelsey & Mitchel Horne, Carley Yates, Jordan & Zach Norrid, Bailey Yates and significant other, Josh Mette, Trenton Hemberger, Sidney McCown, Tyler McCown; great nieces Kaia Horne and Elina Mette; and numerous extended family and friends.
