



Margaret L. "Margie" Hofferber

January 7, 1931 - February 7, 2023

Margaret Lucille (Margie) Hofferber, daughter of Frank J. Neville and Evelyn M.(Cunningham) Neville, was born on January 7, 1931 in York, NE. She passed away on February 7, 2023 at Heritage Crossings in Geneva, NE at the age of 92 years and one month.

Margie grew up on the farm in York, NE and attended country school through 8th grade, then moved to town and lived with her grandmother while attending St. Joseph's High School. After high school, she attended York College where she studied business and began her career in York working as a bookkeeper for various companies.

In April of 1954 Margie married Loren Hofferber at St. Joseph's Church in York and moved to Geneva to start their family. Over the next 14 years they had 5 children. While raising the children Margie continued to work, keeping books and running offices in Geneva including Nichols Construction, Geneva High School and YRTC among many others. Margie was ahead of her time as one of the first women to "work from home". She didn't want to leave her new babies with a sitter and her bosses didn't want to lose her, so they would ask her if she could do their books once she got the children to bed. She nearly always said yes.

If the measure of a person is the number of friends, then Margie's glass

overflowed. She was kind, considerate, fun and always rendering some small deed that endeared her to those who knew her. Never was there a mom more devoted to her family. Their happiness and comfort was always her first consideration and her love for them was as beautiful as it was great.

Margie was one of the last true matriarchs. The glue that held her family together with dignity and strength of character, a strong will, a deep sense of propriety and boundless, endless love. Generous and kind with a very strong faith, Margie's life was filled with family, friends and laughter.

Before her eyesight failed, Margie took enormous pleasure in her flower garden, cooking, baking and hosting family for the holidays or anytime they were able to visit. Spoiling the grandkids was always one of her favorite things to do. And they adored her, too. Many even spending their spring breaks from college with Grandma in Geneva.

She loved spending summer weekends at the lake with Loren and traveling. Of all her travels, the trips to Ireland were some of her favorites. Close seconds to visiting her kids and grandkids.

As her health declined and she was not able to do many of the things she enjoyed, she couldn't give up her time with her Coffee Group. It was always the highlight of her week.

Margie was preceded in death by her parents; husband Loren; her sisters Mary Virginia Eichstedt and Carol (Kalli) Dailey; her brother, Francis J. (Bud) Neville, Jr.; and son-in-law, Mike Schotsch.

She is survived by her brothers Jerry (Carol) Neville and Bob (Marilyn) Neville; Children Karen Schotsch, Kathy (Kirby) Kloppenborg (grandchildren Lauren & Bryan Hoefer, Zachary & Mariel Kloppenborg), Kent (Chris) Hofferber
