She grew up on the farm, doing chores, spending her free time playing with her siblings, and visiting cousins.

She attended School District #49 through 8th grade and graduated from Geneva High School in 1950. On February 13, 1954 she married Leland Rosenquist at St. Mary's Catholic Church near Shickley. To this union 4 children were born: Robert, Leah (Jody), Leland Jr. and Angela.

After her marriage, she worked at a variety of jobs, the last job being at the Shickley State Bank, where she made many lifelong friends.

But most important to her was time spent with family. Every holiday was an excuse to gather the family together, for food, fun and lots of reminiscing. She was always excited at the news that a new grandbaby was on the way.

She was a strong woman with a great sense of humor. When she made a decision, she stuck with it, and when she made a promise, she fulfilled it. Her sense of humor, her strength, but most of all, the love and care she had for all will be missed by all of those who knew her.

MaryAnn was preceded in death by her parents, husband Leland, brother Don, daughter-in-law Jodi, and brother-in-law Lowell Houts.
