Milo M. Jensen was born on June 21, 1914 in Schleswig, Iowa to Henry & Freida (Naeve) Jansen and passed away on March 2, 2011 in Geneva, Nebraska at the age of 96 years, 8 months, and 11 days.

Milo was born on a farm outside of Schleswig. He was an only child. The family moved to Denison, Iowa where Milo graduated from high school. After high school, Milo received a law degree from the University of Nebraska in Lincoln.

He began his law career as county attorney in Denison until he enlisted in World War II in 1942. He was assigned to CIC becoming a staff sergeant seeing action in Europe, Sicily, and North Africa. He was awarded 4 bronze stars and was discharged in 1945.

After returning from the war he married Marion Klotz. The couple moved to Denver, Colorado where Milo became claims manager for National Farmer's Union Insurance Company. The couple lived in Colorado for 50 years. They were blessed with one daughter, Marsha Kennel of Geneva, Nebraska. After retirement, the couple moved to Arizona and later to Nebraska. During his long life, the couple enjoyed fishing, golfing and traveling the world.

Milo is survived by his wife Marion of Geneva; daughter Marsha and husband Dr. Lonnie Kennel of Geneva; grandson Kirk Kennel of Davenport; granddaughter Kate and husband Jim Manes and great grandson, Ben, of Lee's Summit, Missouri.
