



## Mureldine J. Schroder

December 11, 1920 - June 29, 2016

Mureldine Joy (Minich) Schroder passed away peacefully on June 29, 2016 at Heritage Crossings in Geneva at the age of 95 years, 5 months, and 29 days.

She was born December 11, 1920 to Oran "Scott" and Pauline (Schmeltzer) Minich on their farm outside of Friend, Nebraska. She attended the country school through 8th grade. Her family moved to Exeter, Nebraska in 1934. She attended and graduated from Exeter High School in 1938.

Mureldine met Floyd Schroder at a dance in Burress. They married on January 25, 1943. Floyd enlisted in the Coast Guard and they lived in Corpus Christi, Tx. through his time in service after which they moved back to Geneva. They were blessed with two children. Pamela Sue and Terry Lee.

Mureldine was a homemaker. Tending to flowers and vegetables were an important part of her life especially when her and Floyd "Pete" owned the Geneva Nursery. Her other passions were fishing, the outdoor life and playing card games. Later in life Mureldine loved to sew and do crafts. 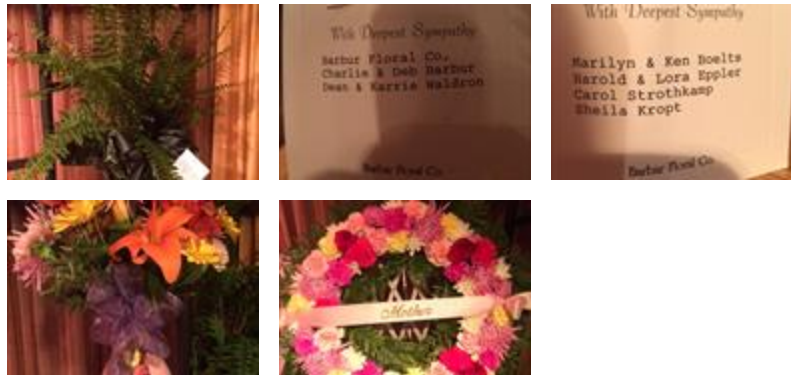
