Naomi Hopperstad was born Alda Naomi Long to Floyd McKinley Long and Iva Grover Long on April 3rd, 1929 at the family home in Exeter, Nebraska. She passed away February 23rd, 2016 at Homestead Rehabilitation Center in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 86. She was the first of six children in her family.

Naomi graduated high school from Lincoln Northeast. She was a homemaker, and her interests included writing, music, travel, history, geneology, and family.
