Patricia Ann Cunningham Grothe, age 86, passed away peacefully on June 6, 2025, at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, Nebraska.

Patricia was born on December 11, 1938, in Albion, Nebraska, to Lawrence and Rosanna Cunningham. Along with her older sister, Darlene, she grew up on a farm near Primrose, Nebraska, where she developed a strong work ethic and a lifelong love of learning. She was active in 4-H throughout her youth, proudly participating in local and state events and earning the title of Miss Cornhusker. In her senior year, her family moved to Cedar Rapids, Nebraska, where she graduated from high school.

She went on to attend the University of Nebraska–Lincoln, where she lived in Love Hall. It was there that a friend invited her on a double blind date—with a Theta XI boy from Geneva—an encounter that would lead to a lifelong love. She later married that young man, Charles F. Grothe, and together they built a life rich in love, laughter, and devotion.

Patricia and Charles raised four children: Michael, Teresa, Mary and Susan.

Charles and Patricia fiercely loved each other for over 50 years—a love that was made tangible through the many handwritten cards and notes they exchanged, treasured keepsakes tucked away in drawers and closets throughout their home. Their marriage was a shining example of enduring partnership, filled with kindness, respect, and deep affection. Charles and Patricia never turned down an opportunity to dance whether it be on a dance floor, next to a pool table at the bar or on a bricked main street, if the music played – they danced.

Charles often described Patricia as having more talent in her pinky finger than most people have in a lifetime. Those talents were displayed in all facets of her life including her skills as a seamstress. Patricia would spend most summers sewing all the new school clothes for her children and later designing and sewing wedding dresses for her daughters. The rehab and life that Patricia gave to the beloved M Street house is a lasting memory for all the family and friends that gathered there over the 20 years Patricia and Charles made that their home.

An exceptionally talented artist, Patricia expressed her creativity through both painting and quilting. She shared that talent with the Geneva community for over two decades as co-owner of The Studio, a cherished frame shop she operated alongside her dear friend and business partner, Peggy Oliva. Her

artistry and eye for beauty touched many lives and homes.

In 2008, Patricia faced one of the greatest challenges of her life when she survived a ruptured aneurysm. Defying the odds, she fought with the strength and determination that had always defined her, inspiring all who knew her with her courage and resilience.

Fiercely competitive and full of life, Patricia brought her energy and sharp spirit to the golf course, tennis court, and any card or board game that crossed her path. She loved a challenge—and she rarely backed down from one.

Patricia is survived by her children and spouses: Micheal and Cindy Grothe, Geneva; Luigi and Teresa Grothe Trucchi, San Diego, CA; Pat and Mary Grothe McCabe, Naples, FL; and Jay and Susan Grothe Lynch, Geneva. 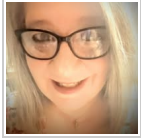
