Patricia Ann (Dunker) Rippe was born to Roy Elmer Dunker and Alfreida Mae Wolter Dunker on September 13, 1929 on a farm near Strang, Nebraska. She passed away December 15, 2016, at Hebron, Nebraska at the age of 87 years, 3 months and 2 days. She was one of three children in the family.

As a youth, she received several perfect spelling awards. She was also crowned queen at a school carnival in 1942. She attended elementary school at District 38 and 84 and graduated from Ohioa High School in 1946.

Pat married Willard Roy Rippe of Ohioa, Nebraska on September 26, 1948,

at Pat's parents' home. To this union two daughters were born, Susan and Cheryl.

Pat was a 4-H leader for many years. She was also a long-time member of the Strang Sewing Club. She was a member of Grace Lutheran Church and served on the church council.

Pat and Willard lived and farmed on the Dunker homestead near Strang. After Willard's parents retired, they moved to Ohio and lived on their farm. After retiring, Willard and Pat moved to Bruning. When their health began to fail in 2010, they both moved to Blue Valley Lutheran Nursing Home in Hebron. Pat was very happy there, calling it "home."

Pat loved playing dominoes and attending the other activities at the home. She looked forward to seeing her grandkids and great-grandkids. They made her day!

Patricia was preceded in death by her mother and father, Alfreida and Roy Dunker; her husband, Willard; her brother, Frederick Dunker; and her sister, Gretchen Dunker.
