Randall Keith "Randy" Compton was born on October 28, 1951, to Lester and Fern (Schmitt) Compton in Fairbury, NE, and passed away on January 17, 2026, at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, NE, at the age of 74. He was the oldest of 3 children in the family.

Randy was born in Fairbury, NE, and made several moves with his family during his Kindergarten through 12th-grade school years, including Aurora, Superior, and Norfolk, all in Nebraska. He graduated from Superior High School in 1970. When Randy was 25, he moved to Sheldon, IA., where he lived and worked at Village Northwest Unlimited for 40 years. He made his final move to Fairview Manor in Fairmont, NE, where he finished his journey in

life here on earth.
